



FOR YOU AND YOUR CHILDREN

Coldspring - Oakhurst CISD will continue to operate the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) under the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and School Breakfast Program (SBP) for 2023-2024 school year.

What does this mean for your child/children? He or she is eligible for FREE BREAKFAST and FREE LUNCH at their school during the 2023-24 school year. Your child/children can participate in school breakfast and lunch without having to pay a fee or submit an application and help ensure students receive nutritious meals. No further action is required by you.

All meals will meet federal and state guidelines.

Students must take 3 of the 4 items offered at breakfast, and 1 of those items must be $\frac{1}{2}$ cup fruit/vegetable. At lunch, students must take 3 of the 5 components offered and 1 of those items must be a $\frac{1}{2}$ cup fruit or vegetable. All cafeterias offer a variety of fruits and vegetables daily.



Students who wish to purchase an extra entree or one of our snack options or just milk must pay for them. *This program does not apply to a la carte items.*
