COCISD staff continues to work through the coordination of providing instruction for all of our students. Academic packets developed by district and campus instructional staff are being prepared this week for distribution beginning on Monday, March 23, 2020. To ensure that all students have access to the mandatory academic packet as rapidly as possible, the district will make it available by posting a copy on the website at www.cocisd.org and provide paper copies for pick up at Coldspring Intermediate during the curbside Grab-and-Go meal program beginning Monday, March 23rd from 10:45 AM to 1:45 PM. Additionally, academic packets may be picked up at the meal distribution points listed below each weekday beginning Monday, March 23rd from 10:45 AM to 1:45 PM:

Teachers and instructional staff will be available Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM via phone and online links, contact details will be provided by each teacher. Educators will remain in contact with each student during the at home instruction period. Even though we are not physically meeting on the campus, the district is still required to engage students in the learning process. As of now the learning packets are how COCISD is delivering instruction to ensure that all students are receiving lessons from their teachers. All packets will be collected from the students for a grade on April 6, 2020 unless the date changes due to Texas Education Agency requirements.

An online survey will be posted on the district website by March 23, 2020 inquiring about each student's household ability to receive academic instruction and communicate with teachers. Feedback will assist the district in developing instructional plans and resources to ensure the best academic instruction, as we plan educational provisions moving forward.

We will continue to meet with state and local officials for the latest updates on the situation, and will keep you updated as more information becomes available.
